





Beautiful Lake Greenwood, 26 miles long and 2 miles wide at its broadest, comprises approximately 11,400 acres of surface water and 180 miles of shoreline. Pool elevation is approximately 446 feet above sea level with adjacent shoreline areas rising to over 505 feet. The maximum depth is 70 feet. Shoreline development is extensive and is characterized by numerous piers and docks.

Moderate temperatures in the Lake Greenwood area allow for year-round fishing and other recreational activities.
