Guidelines for the S.C. Environmental Awareness Award
The S.C. Environmental Awareness Award is presented annually in late winter/early spring. Its purpose is to
promote awareness of the environment and acknowledge exemplary accomplishments in the protection,
conservation, and improvement of our natural resources. Areas of accomplishment include, but are not
limited to:
Protection, conservation, or improvement of soil, water, or air;
Protection or conservation of native plants, animals, or their habitats;
Improvement of natural resource management;
☐ Benefits to wildlife (game or non-game); and
Increased recreational or aesthetic values.
The recipient* must:
☐ Be a South Carolina resident;
Possess upstanding moral character;
 Exemplify extraordinary dedication to preserving and improving the environment and natural resources of South Carolina.
*Note: All nominees will be considered for two consecutive award periods.
Criteria:
Nominations will be judged on the impact of accomplishments. For example:
 Degree of innovativeness, originality, or pioneering that enhance
environmental protection and preservation;
 Degree that contributions promote leadership in preserving and protecting the
environment and natural resources;
Size, scope, and impact of accomplishment;
 Degree that efforts promote educational opportunities for the public;
 Degree that accomplishments influence positive changes affecting the environment at the local, state, or national level;
Short or long-term benefits to the environment.
