Lifetime Licenses available to South Carolina residents only. For the purpose of applying for a Lifetime License “resident” means any person who is a citizen of the United States and who has been a domiciled (permanent) resident of the state of South Carolina for a period of 180 consecutive days or more immediately prior to the date of application for license. **A copy of a South Carolina driver’s license must accompany application.** (Ownership of property or payment of property taxes or both does not necessarily constitute residency.)

- LIFETIME SENIOR LICENSE (64 years of age or older)\$9.00
- GRATIS LICENSE (Available only to residents born on or before 7/1/1940).....NO COST

Lifetime Senior License includes State Hunting License, Freshwater Fishing License, Saltwater Fishing License, Big Game Permit, WMA Permit, and State Duck Stamp.

- MIGRATORY BIRD PERMIT.....NO COST
