Description	The Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) Program is a FEMA grant that is managed by the SC Emergency Management Division (SCEMD). The goal of this grant is to reduce the risk of loss of life and property from future disasters. Applicants do not need to have sustained disaster related damage to apply for HMGP.	The Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) Program is a FEMA grant that is managed by the SC Emergency Management Division (SCEMD). The goal of this grant is to reduce the risk of loss of life and property from future disasters.	The Flood Mitigation Assistance (FMA) Program is a FEMA grant that is managed by the SC Department of Natural Resources (SCDNR). The goal of this grant is to reduce flooding of National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) insured properties through mitigation, thereby, reducing flood insurance claims.	The Community Development Block Grant – Mitigation is a Federal HUD grant that is managed by the South Carolina Office of Resilience (SCOR). Its purpose is to increase resilience to disasters and reduce or eliminate the long-term risk of loss of life, injury, damage to and loss of property, and suffering and hardship, by lessening the impact of future disasters.
Availability and Funding	Available after a federally declared disaster. Funding amount is typically 15% of total estimated federal assistance for the disaster. Typically competitive statewide	Notice of Funding Opportunity usually comes out in Late Summer/Early Fall. Funded by 6% set-aside of annual FEMA disaster expenses. Competitive nationwide	Funded by the National Flood Insurance Fund. Notice of Funding Opportunity usually comes out in Late Summer/Early Fall. Competitive nationwide	A Federal Register Notice specifies the HUD funds allocation amount, coverage areas, and allowable activities. At least 50% of the entire grant will support the LMI population. Annual opportunities will be available for Buyout and Infrastructure. Year-round funding opportunities are available for Match and Plans & Studies. See website for eligible communities.
