MINUTES OF MEETING OF WILDLIFE RESOURCES COMMISSION AT BELMONT MAY 9, 1962

Present were Commissioners Johnson, Cox, Cantey, Hopkins and Tison, Director Webb, Chief of Law Enforcement Ryan and Chief of Game Nelson.

The Commission discussed at length the salaries of all personnel and the recommended raises, qualifications of each employee being discussed in approving salary increases. The salary increases recommended by the Director were approved with minor changes.

The Commission approved the recommended re-appointments of wardens whose commissions expire in July and the appointment and re-appointment of several non-pay wardens.

A resolution was adopted commending the work of Bob Stevens and those who assisted him for their tireless and devoted service in making the rockfish hatchery a success.

Another resolution was adopted commending the Division of Game for its accomplishments during the past year.

Mr. Ryan gave a report on recent use of the plane in combating night hunting and on other activities of the Law Enforcement Section.

The Commission also heard reports from Mr. Nelson on the activities of the biologists on several management areas, and especially the recently-acquired Dirleton plantation. He reported that the dragline was already in operation on the plantation building dams and dikes.
