The matter of management and regulations for the 12,000-acre reservoir above the present Spartanburg water works lake was discussed and it was decided to continue the matter until the next meeting, by which time Director Webb said he should have information from the Attorney General

Director Webb was authorized to sign a lease for the one acre access area on the Fee Dee river in Darlington county and also to approve the wording of the signs that would be placed.
