State Lakes and Infrastructure Challenges

Ross Self, Chief of Fisheries, spoke about the conditions and infrastructure needs of the 18 State Lakes managed by SCDNR. A hand-out with the State Lakes names and their locations was provided.

The South Carolina Bobwhite Initiative

Michael Hook, Small Game Program Coordinator, gave a presentation on the South Carolina Bobwhite Initiative Program. With participation from private landowners and various partnerships, the bobwhite population is slowly making a comeback in South Carolina. Mr. Hook presented the National Bobwhite Conservation Initiative (NBCI) Firebird Award to Jack Valentine for his contributions to South Carolina's efforts toward habitat-based restoration of wild bobwhite populations.

2019/2020 Waterfowl Season Update

Billy Dukes, Chief of Wildlife, presented the 2019/2020 waterfowl season update. It was a slow year due to the abundance of water and warm weather. Category 1 areas averaged 2.9 ducks per hunter, with the top 3 areas being Springfield at Bear Island, followed by The Cape and Murphy Island. The top 3 species harvested were gadwall, green-winged teal, and blue-winged teal.

Action Item

A. Category 1 Waterfowl Area Modifications

Proposed by Billy Dukes: SCDNR proposed removing Samworth and Wateree WMA's from Category 1 lottery hunts for at least one year for improvements to be made to the properties. Stephen Thomas made a motion to exclude Samworth and Wateree WMA's from the Category 1 hunts for the 2020/2021 duck season. Titus Duren seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.
