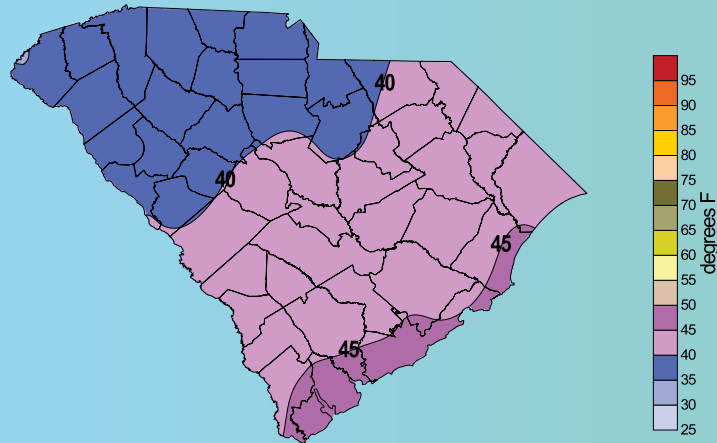
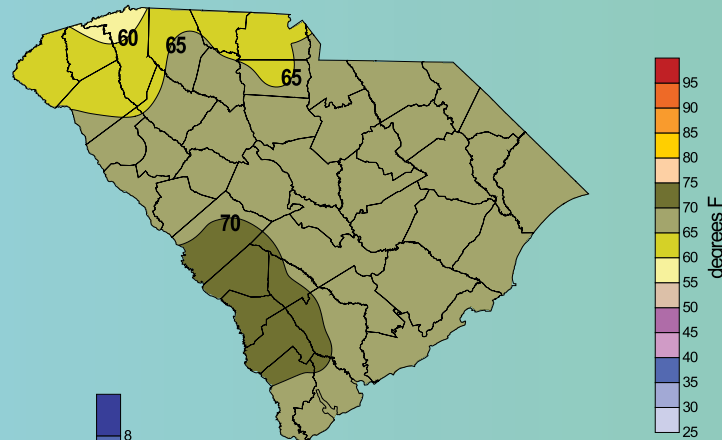

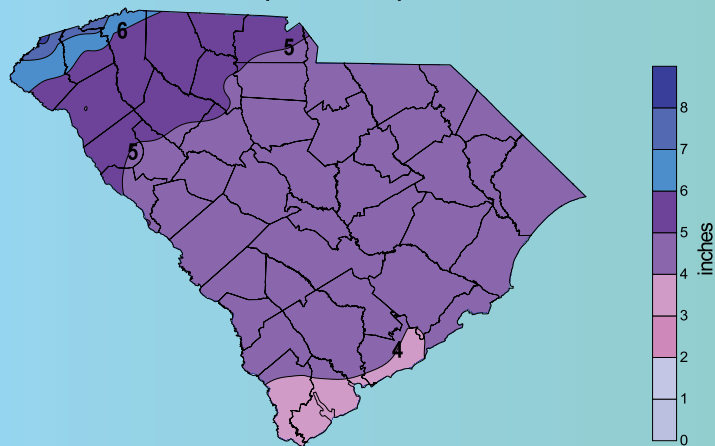
**March Average Minimum Temperature
