Disability Licenses available to South Carolina residents only. For the purpose of applying for a Disability License "resident" means any person who is a citizen of the United States and who has been a domiciled (permanent) resident of the state of South Carolina for a period of one year or more immediately prior to the date of application for license. **A copy of a South Carolina driver's license or reasonable proof of residency must accompany application.** (Ownership of property or payment of property taxes or both does not necessarily constitute residency.)

DISABILITY CERTIFICATION

SC Code of Law, Sec. 50-9-510 (16) provides that any person who has been a domiciled resident of South Carolina for at least one year and who is determined to be **totally disabled** under one of the programs listed below, may obtain a statewide fishing and hunting license at no cost. It is valid only for three years from date of issue and disability recertification will be required for renewal. Check the program below that has certified you as totally disabled and attach a current year copy of such agency certification to this form. Application forms received without such documentation will be returned to the applicant.
